product versus foreign product. You may have heard that the KCMA (Kitchen Cabinet Manufacturing Association) has an anti-dumping/countervailing petition trade case before the International Trade Commission with a final decision coming down next March in the US. This petition has taken more than two years and the US kitchen industry will be impacted. In the meantime, the trade war between the US and China heats up and leaves uncertainty in the industry. Consumers are paying attention and the outcome of these trade wars will be felt.

CKCA has already received calls from dealers in the US looking to Canadian manufacturers for product in anticipation that tariffs will make the purchase of foreign imports more expensive. But no matter the outcome in the US, Canadian manufacturers need to tell consumers why they should buy Canadian and we encourage you to use the tools we have created. CKCA will be monitoring the progress in the US and 2020 is shaping up to be a very interesting year!
